Developmental Sequence	Unit Dimension	Unit Theme/ Title	Unit Focus
Introductory - Early	Social	<i>Mémo-photos</i>	A picture is worth a thousand words! Students focus on learning how photos can tell a personal story. Students develop their own photo-history.
Early - Mid	Leisure	<i>Venez chez nous!</i>	What's the most exciting thing about where you live? Students focus on travel highlights from their own region and discover those of various Francophone cultures.
Early - Mid	Physical	<i>Bon appétit!</i>	What's your favourite food? Students discuss food from their favourite celebrations and holidays. They focus on traditional dishes and recipes from various Francophone celebrations.
Early - Mid	Social	<i>Salut, mes amis!</i>	Friends are forever! Students focus on friendship symbols in their own culture and various Francophone cultures around the world.
Mid - Late	Civic	<i>À toi le choix!</i>	"Take my advice!" Students focus on peer pressure issues and examine public service announcements geared toward these issues.
Mid - Late	Intellectual	<i>Incognito</i>	Who do you want to be? Students learn to describe masks and face paint. Students learn how to portray their personality through these two media.
