Developmental Sequence	Unit Dimension	Unit Theme/ Title	Unit Focus
Introductory - Early	Social/ Intellectual	<i>L'école de l'avenir</i>	What would you invent to make school easier or more fun? Students identify challenges they face in the modern-day classroom and consider possible inventions that might address these challenges. They design a fun invention for the classroom to help future students.
Early - Mid	Leisure/ Physical	<i>Aventures en plein air</i>	Outdoor adventures have never been so accessible! Students explore outdoor education companies and their trips. They create their own outdoor education company and plan an advertising campaign.
Early - Mid	Physical/ Civic	<i>Mon style, ma mode</i>	What is cool? Students share fashion preferences and examine the importance of fashion in their lives. They design and present their own line of clothing in a fashion show.
Early - Mid	Leisure/ Physical	<i>Mordu du sport!</i>	What is your favourite sport? Students draw on their personal experience as sports spectators. Students create a sportscast of sports results, deliver a commentary and conduct an interview with an athlete.
Mid - Late	Intellectual	<i>Musique-mania!</i>	Who are you listening to? Students discuss current musical artists and trends. They create a web page for their favourite artist/s and share their favourite song with the class.
Mid - Late	Civic	<i>Action jeunesse</i>	Is there anything we can do? Students learn about initiatives of both youth and adults to address humanitarian issues. In groups, students plan a project to support a humanitarian cause or organization.
