

## Theme Overview\*

Developmental Sequence	Unit Dimension	Unit Theme/ Title	Unit Focus
Introductory - Early	Intellectual/ Social	<i>Ma chambre, ma vie</i>	What does your ideal bedroom look like? Based on the current popularity of design shows, students redefine their favourite living space – their bedroom. Students play the role of designers and propose design plans to their partners.
Early - Mid	Social	<i>Mission: emploi!</i>	The thrill of the first job! Students apply for a part-time or summer job, using knowledge about multiple intelligences to make their choice. They complete an application form, write a resume and participate in an interview.
Early - Mid	Civic/ Intellectual	<i>Nous, les Canadiens</i>	Brush up on your Canadian trivia! Students explore Canadian geography, history and art and discuss Canadian heroes. They use this knowledge to prepare and play a trivia game called <i>Défi-Canada</i> .
Early - Mid	Intellectual/ Leisure	<i>Mes trésors, mes souvenirs</i>	What are your favourite childhood memories? Students reminisce about favourite toys, games, activities, TV shows and books. They create a memory box and share their memories with classmates.
Mid - Late	Leisure/ Intellectual	<i>Films à l'affiche!</i>	Now playing at a theatre near you! Students talk about the movies they like to see and various aspects of film. They create original short films and vote for their favourite.
