



## YEAR-AT-A-GLANCE – GRADE 4 PROGRAM

### GENERAL INFORMATION

Year-at-a-glance is a tool designed to assist teachers with planning their social studies lessons throughout the school year. It is based on approximately 36 weeks of instruction in a classroom with five 30-minute social studies lessons per week.

The chart provides an easy to read quick reference.

Grade four is divided into three units as outlined in the **Student text** and the **Teacher's guide**. Below is a description of the organization of the year-at-a-glance chart:

### WEEK

This is an estimated amount of time to cover content and student activities suggested in the teaching plans.

### TEACHER'S GUIDE

This column provides a link to the teacher's guide.

### TEXT BOOK TITLE/PAGES NUMBER OF LESSONS

Headings help to link back to the teacher's guide and the student text. The numbers listed in this column match the estimated number of lessons and instructional time outlined in the margin of each teaching plan. This will allow for opportunities to highlight content or activity suggestions found in the Many Voices lesson model: Engage, Explore, Elaborate and Extend. Teaching notes may be inserted next to each lesson by downloading the chart onto your own computer.

### LINE MASTERS

This column identifies line masters corresponding with the student material and activities outlined in each teaching plan, which are also referenced in the margins of the teacher's guide.

### SKILL POWER

Highlights the on-going curriculum skills for each chapter, which are introduced and practiced throughout the program.

### ASSESSMENT

Assessment masters and their reference numbers are displayed and organized to assist with planning for assessment.
